REQUIREMENTS TO THE ABSTRACTS

The paper size: A4 (21 × 29,7 cm). Page Options (Margins) on the Left - 2.5 cm; Right - 2.0 cm; Top – 2.0 cm; Bottom - 2.5 cm.

The font – Times New Roman, Font style – Regular; Size – 10 pt, Line spacing (At) – 1. Text of theses is located in the two columns of equal width – 8 cm, The spacing between the columns – 0,5 cm; Paragraph First line – 0,75 cm; Alignment – Justified. Literature is executed according to IEEE Style.

The abstract – 1 full page A4 format.

Do not use text formatting spaces, tabs, etc. Do not set the manual hyphenation, do not use headers and footers. ATTENTION! The theses Page filled to not less than 3/4. A set of formulas: MS Equation formula editor. References and e-mail the author(s) are required (example of abstracts, bibliography included). At the end of the abstract specify the scientific supervisor.
